

EXCLUSION REQUEST FORM
(Complete and Return via mail or email to opt out of the Class)

If you are a Class Member, do not want to participate in the lawsuit, and do not want to be legally bound by the Class, you must exclude yourself from the Class by **FEBRUARY 18, 2025**. If you do this, you will NOT receive any recovery that may occur but retain any rights you may have to sue the Defendants regarding the legal claims at issue in this lawsuit.

To opt out, you must mail or email your completed Exclusion Request Form to the Notice Administrator (contact information below). The date of the postmark on the return mailing envelope or the timestamp on the electronic submission shall be the exclusive means used to determine whether a request for exclusion has been timely submitted. Any mailing or electronic submission that is postmarked or timestamped after **FEBRUARY 18, 2025**, shall be deemed untimely.

Your written request for exclusion must include your full name and current address. Your signature on the Exclusion Request Form represents a statement that you wish to be excluded from the Class. The Exclusion Request Form must be signed by you (an electronic signature qualifies). If you exclude yourself, you will not receive potential benefits from this Class, but you will keep your legal rights, if any, to sue on the claims alleged in this lawsuit at your own expense.
